- Develop technical standards to determine effective maintenance procedures.
- Foster a collaborative work environment by liaising closely with other staff members, promoting a team-oriented approach in school operations and HVAC maintenance.
- Work based on oral and/or written instructions and established procedures, ensuring precision and efficiency.
- Maintain positive relationships with school administration, staff, and students, contributing to a conducive learning atmosphere.
- Assist in loading and unloading of vehicles when required.

- Physically capable and prepared to perform all aspects of Maintenance Trades work.
- Minimum of two years of recent experience in building Mechanical Systems, including Direct Digital Control (DDC) systems.
- Thorough understanding of HVAC maintenance procedures and equipment.
- Ability to perform heavy lifting and work at heights, including using ladders or scaffolds.
- Proficiency in operating protective equipment.
- Strong organizational skills to effectively manage work tasks.
- Successful completion of courses in conflict resolution and management, or equivalent experience in a leadership role.
- Possess a valid B.C. Driver's License: Class 5 minimum.
- Hold a Grade 12 Diploma.
