Policy Development Responsibilities

- Work with Blockchain for Climate Partnership team to facilitate uptake of the BITMO Platform by international parties to the Paris Agreement.
- Lead research on international parties to the Paris Agreement to develop a strategy to convene international party working group participants.
- Lead development of the international party working group by convening participants to pilot the BITMO Platform.
- Develop and maintain constructive relationships with international party working group members, Blockchain industry leaders, media, other NGOs, and government.
- Support outreach to policymakers and decision-makers including development of meeting materials and coordination of meetings with key decision-makers.

Other Valuable Qualifications:

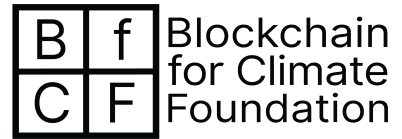
- Experience in working with governments on climate change and tech policy infrastructure.
