To complement your Diploma in GIS or closely related discipline with a GIS focus, you **will** also have:

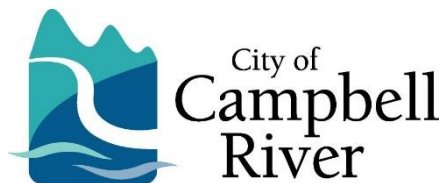
- A minimum of two years applicable industry experience, largely focused on GIS and related software applications such as the ESRI platform and GeoCortex.
