STOPPING THE VIOLENCE PROGRAM

Women's Counsellor (FT)

Our Women's Counsellors focus on supporting and empowering women to develop safe and healthy relationships, taking personal responsibility for their behaviours and building effective coping strategies and problem solving skills

Women's/PEACE (Previously CWWA)

This fulltime, combined position (14 hrs/wk Women's Counselling; 21 hrs/wk PEACE) provides STV counselling to women, and individual and group counselling to children and their parents/caregivers who have witnessed and/or experienced abuse or high conflict in their lives.

A post-secondary degree and 2 years related experience for both these positions is suggested, although other combinations of education and experience will be considered.

Women's Outreach (10 hrs/wk)

Working as part of our Women's Outreach team, you will offer individual and group support for women 19 years and over who have experienced, or are at risk of experiencing, violence in an intimate relationship or other relationships of trust. This work can also include providing referrals, information, accompaniment to appointments (doctors, lawyers, social services, addiction services, etc.), and assistance with budgeting, internet research, securing housing, goal setting, and more.
